


The workshops will take place at:

Workshops in English at the University of Potsdam – July 2016

In July 2016, we at the TEFL department of the University of Potsdam (UP) are offering workshops for pupils who want to collect and promote their ideas for such a shared future.

The workshops are designed by university students and will give pupils the chance to work together in projects with pupils from other schools.

Every school class will be divided into different groups. Each group will then be mixed with pupils from another school and they will work together in one of the workshops offered.

Working together cooperatively and creatively will not only improve pupils' communicative competence, but will also increase their motivation to deal with this relevant topic.

In order to put your ideas on the market, you will design city cards, posters, develop amateur films, and create much more to promote your ideas for integrating refugees into our communities. You will step into the shoes of project planners, designers, script writers, or any other person possibly involved in the process of getting into action.
